XBT-3535-UV-Mini LEDs are tested at a drive current of 150 mA, 20 ms single pulse at 25°C and placed into one of the following radiometric flux and wavelength bins. The LEDs can also be driven at different drive currents to achieve the correlated flux values listed in the table.














Peak Wavelength Shift



Angular distribution and Typical Spectrum


Angular distribution

 $I_{ref} = f(\Phi); T_{c} = 25^{\circ}C$




Typical Spectrum





- 3. During the pick and place process, axial forces on the dome (or window) should not exceed 0.5 Newtons (N).
- 4. Use of a multi-zone IR reflow oven with a nitrogen blanket is recommended.
- 5. Time-temperature profile of the reflow process showing the four functional profile zones are defined in IPC-7801. Temperature is referenced to the center of the PCB
- $6. \ Luminus\ recommends\ to\ use\ the\ solder\ paste\ data\ sheet\ information\ as\ a\ starting\ point\ in\ time\ temperature\ process\ development.$





Recommended Solder Pad




Shipping Reel Outline

Packing Configuration:

Notes

Static Electricity
